## Programme Fees

### Stage 2 Payment

This should be paid **no less than 12 weeks** before you depart for Camp.

To make your stage two payment, please log into your account to make this payment.

### Final Payment

This should be submitted **no less than 8 weeks** before you depart for Camp.

# Flights

Now it's time to get your flights sorted! Our in-house flight team will soon be in touch to discuss travel options with you.

If you choose to book your flights elsewhere, please refer to the information below to assist you with your booking.



## Arrival Information

Whichever flight option you choose, aim to arrive into Phnom Penh before 3.00pm on your arrival date. This will give you plenty of time to clear immigration and customs, ready for pick up at 4pm. Our reps will be waiting for you in the arrivals lounge. If you arrive after the designated pick up time you will need to get a taxi to the hotel in Phnom Penh and meet the team there.



## Departure Information

Camp Cambodia is a 3-week program, with return travel provided for you back to Phnom Penh after Camp is over. On the last day of Camp you will set off back to Phnom Peng in the morning, arriving later that afternoon. You could book a flight later that night or, to allow for any travel disruptions, stay in Phnom Penh for an extra night and fly the following day. Time for some last minute souvenir shopping!

**Remember, if you're booked onto our Island Tour, please speak to a Camp Cambodia team member before you book your return flight home.**

# DBS Check

Before arriving in Cambodia, you will need to have completed a DBS criminal background check. It is part of Camp Cambodia's policy to request this check, as you will be working with children whilst at Camp.



The cost is **£48.86**. Please complete this payment as soon as possible by logging into your account, clicking 'Purchase New' and choose the 'Police Check' option.

Once payment has been processed, you will receive an email from the DBS containing your direct log in details. You will need to follow the instructions and log in online, then submit all required personal information. Then, please send a copy of your passport or driving license and proof of address to [info@CampCambodia.org](mailto:info@CampCambodia.org) so your documents can be cross-checked by the team and submitted to the DBS.

Once complete, you will receive your certificate in the post.  
**Please bring this along to Camp.**

If you are from outside the UK, you will need to visit your local police station to complete a background check.

# Health, Insurance & Vaccines

So, you've sorted your flights and DBS check, now it's time to sort out your insurance and Health history form.



## Insurance

---

Before coming to Cambodia you will need to obtain travel insurance. This should cover such things as medical expenses, trip cancellation, lost luggage, flight accident and other losses incurred whilst at Camp/any travelling afterwards.

Once you have organised this, please make sure you send us a copy of your policy to [info@CampCambodia.org](mailto:info@CampCambodia.org) and print a copy to take with you.

## Health

---

Everyone coming to Cambodia needs to complete the 3-page Health History Form (that we'll send to you) and return it to [info@CampCambodia.org](mailto:info@CampCambodia.org). You will need to book an appointment with your GP to get these forms completed within 3 months of your trip. You must fill in the 'Pre-Existing Medical Condition Questionnaire' that is at the beginning of the Health History Form if this applies to you. If any question does not apply to you, simply write N/A but you still must have it signed by your GP. Please be aware that there may be an additional charge to get your forms completed. This is at your GP's discretion.

## Vaccines

---

There are certain vaccines you will need to get before flying to Cambodia. There's a few which are required, and a few more that are only recommended. It is your responsibility to get all the required vaccines. Since some vaccines require a number of injections over a period of weeks, you should consult and visit your nurse at least 12 weeks before you fly to ensure you have enough time to complete the vaccine programme. The nurse will ask which area of Cambodia you will be visiting which will be Phnom Penh and Siem Reap. For updated information please click [HERE](#).

## Visa

---

There are a few different options for your visa, depending upon how long you wish to stay in Cambodia for. All visas applied for must be used within 3 months of issue. The team will be happy to advise and give you all the appropriate information on this, so please contact the office for any assistance.

## More Information

---

Before you leave for Camp Cambodia you will receive a Pre-Departure Pack containing a packing list, information on Cambodian culture/language and your Camp Cambodia itinerary. Already thinking about what to pack?

3 months prior to your Camp start date, a Facebook group dedicated to your intake date will be created so you can start to get to know all your new best friends before you head to Cambodia! This is also a great way to organise onward travel with others who will be at Camp at the same time you will be.
